The Assessment and Intake Unit of the Refugee Law Project (RLP) operates under Operations and Program Support.

It handles all internal clients that walk into the RLP. It is at this level that SGBV cases, legal and psychosocial supports are identified and preliminary CMS processes are handled before program referrals are made. It is also at this level that the unit manages clients' expectations, re-emphasizes RLP mandate and for cases that fall outside the RLP Mandate, external referrals to partner organizations are made.

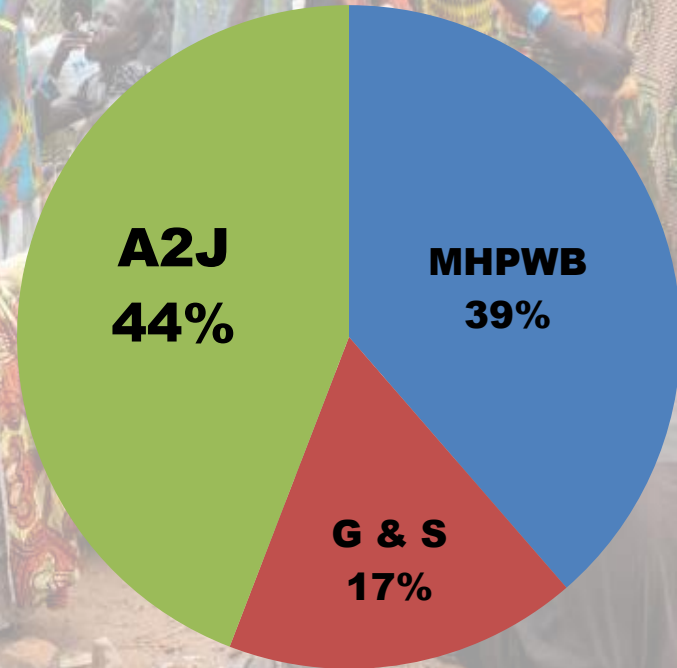
