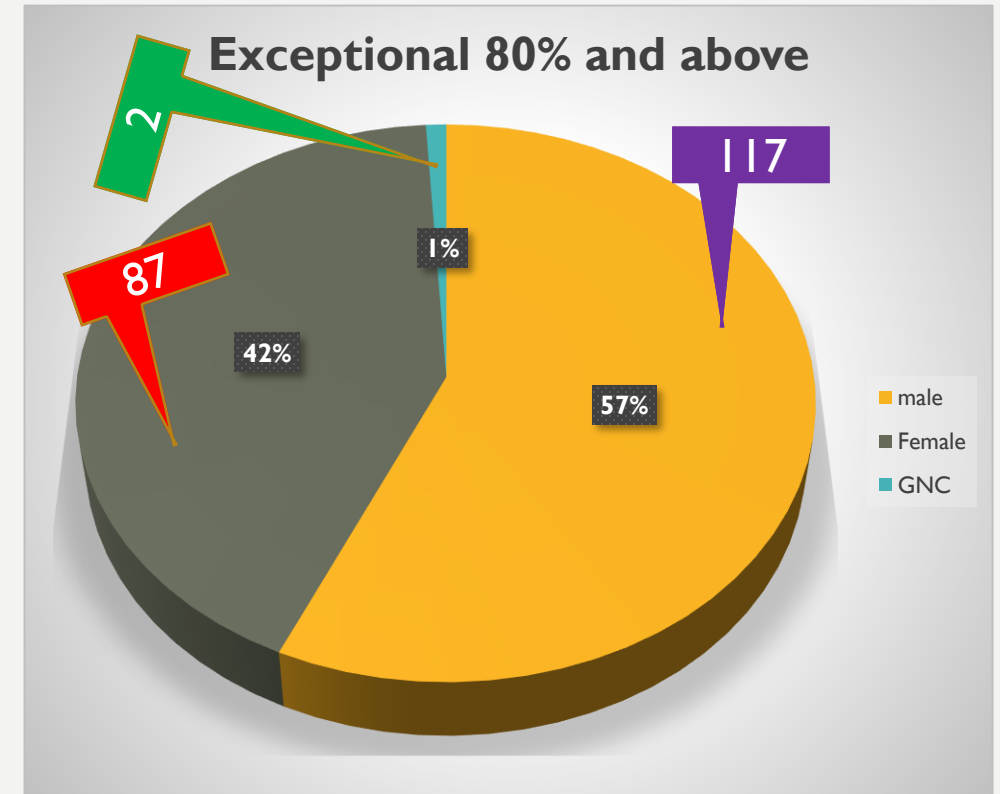

- Mobilization of community, needs to be done directly through the community leaders and also community Interpreters

PLANS FOR 2019

- Holding the EFA team retreat on 14th and 15th of January 2019 (**on Improving Service Delivery**)
- Develop and use an online reporting and data management system for EFA
- Engage in local, national, regional and international advocacy on matters of Adult learning especially for Forced Migrants
- Network and Partner with different Institutions with whom we can collectively implement different activities and serve the forced migrants community
- Launch the EFA “Speak Your Rights” Curriculum and lay foundations for the development of facilitator’s guide and other relevant learning Aids
- An analysis to be conducted to find out the reasons as to why few men participate in EFA classes (Research)
- Create competitions for learners to participate in; writing
- Increased Support Supervision
